

Virginia Federation of Humane Societies Achievement Awards

The Virginia Federation of Humane Societies has established several awards to honor those who have made a difference in animal welfare. Recipients of the awards are recognized at the VFHS annual conference.

Award Categories

The Bravo Award is presented to an individual who has demonstrated a commitment of outstanding service to promote animal welfare, who has been instrumental in making an impact within an animal welfare organization and who is a reflection of the values and standards set by the Virginia Federation of Humane Societies.

The Compassion Award is presented to a member organization that has demonstrated strong leadership qualities and has excelled in promoting animal welfare issues and or programs.

The Humanitarian Award is presented to an Animal Control Officer who has established a positive relationship and maintained the safety and health within the community, who has made a significant impact on improving the image of the animal control profession within the community and who has demonstrated overall excellence in the performance of his or her job.

The Ayrshire Award is presented to a member organization that has made a significant contribution to reducing pet overpopulation through spay/neuter services and resources within the community.

The Companion Award is established to honor an adopted animal that has made a tremendous contribution to our lives. The Virginia Federation of Humane Societies would like to honor those animals that exemplify the strength and value of the human animal bond. This award is presented to an adopted animal that has provided a benefit to their human companion or community through saving or preserving human life.

The Veterinary Partnership Award is established to recognize a veterinarian dedicated to volunteering time and services to promote the welfare of animals in conjunction with an agency that provides direct care to animals. This award is presented to a veterinarian whose donated services support a local animal care and control center or an animal shelter or rescue group, in its efforts to provide veterinary care for homeless and abused animals.
